<i>Event Description:</i>	<p>This is a 2-day course designed to equip practitioners with the skills and knowledge to work 1-2-1 with parents to help them re-build positive attachment with their children.</p> <p>(Terms and conditions apply, available on website at time of booking.)</p>
<i>Learning Outcomes:</i>	<p>By the end of the event, participants will have had the opportunity to learn about and explore:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How to work through this 8 session Attachment Parenting Programme with parents on a one-to-one basis where there are recognised attachment problems.</li> <li>• How to enable parents to develop a ‘Relational approach’ rather than a ‘Behavioural approach’ to parenting.</li> <li>• Why the attachment problems occurred and help parents to acknowledge that they need to re-establish attachment with their child.</li> <li>• That this approach works on the basis of ‘no blame’ and supports parents as they acknowledge how this has impacted on their child.</li> <li>• The difficulties children experience getting through every day.</li> <li>• Why the family are experiencing the chaos that a child with attachment problems can create.</li> <li>• That this is a sensitive subject and every family experience is unique</li> <li>• How to create a supportive, honest and fun setting</li> <li>• How the process should be adapted to the family’s needs</li> <li>• How to ensure that parents/carers are truly engaging in the programme and understand the dynamics that can arise during this type of work.</li> <li>• That there is a strong link between lack of attachment and child abuse and neglect.</li> </ul>
<i>Target Group:</i>	<p>For those Bournemouth, Christchurch or Poole practitioners who have already completed the 2-day Level one training course with Future Childcare Training; ‘<i>Emotional Attachment and Resilience in Early Years</i>’ or ‘<i>Understanding and Working with Attachment Problems</i>’ either as a stand-alone course or as part of the 6 day ‘<i>Building Healthy Emotional Development for Children and Young People</i>’.</p>
