Event Description:	<p>This is a two-day course designed to introduce practitioners to Bournemouth’s Early Help Arrangements, the Early Help Assessment and Support Plan (formally fCAF) Multi-Agency collaboration and planning within a TAF (team Around the Family.)</p> <p>(A third follow up module is also available, designed to build upon and enhance practitioner’s experience of using the Early Help Assessment and working with partner agencies. Ideally this would occur 6-12 months after the first 2 modules have been completed).</p> <p><i>(Terms and conditions apply, available on website at time of booking.)</i></p>
Learning Outcomes:	<p>By the end of the Event, participants will have had the opportunity to learn about and explore:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bournemouth's Early Help Arrangements and your service, agency or school • The importance of keeping the child/young person at the centre of the process • How to use the Early Help Assessment tool to effectively support the identifications of needs with a whole family approach • How to look at the 'whole' picture of the child/young person • How to conduct effective assessment and analyse the needs of children, young people and their families • Identifying the key areas to consider when assessing strengths and needs • How to construct effective and SMART action plans that focus on improved outcomes for children, young people and their families • How to positively and effectively assume the role of Lead Professional
Target Group:	<p>Available for all Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole practitioners at the subsidised rate, who work with children, young people and their families to improve their outcomes: Including Private, Voluntary and Independent sector, Schools, Health and Local Authority staff.</p> <p>Especially those whose job role requires them to be a Lead Professional or member of a TAF (Team Around the Family) using the Bournemouth Early Help Assessment.</p>
